## One of Utah's best Jazz group celebrates a new CD at The Egyptian Theatre

Park City, UT - December 20, 2010 - John Flanders has been giving endless performances and recordings to the Utah music scene for decades now, and his new cd; "The Go Between" with his band Double Helix rates right at the top. (John has worked with the likes of Billy Preston, Solomon Burke, Rodney Dangerfield, The Temptations, Donovan etc.)

Come celebrate the new CD with a release party and concert Sunday, January 9, 6pm at the Egyptian Theatre on Main Street in Park City. Tickets are \$12 in advance, \$15 at the door and \$20 for cabaret seating, 10% of the proceeds from the CD will go to Amnesty International.

The all original swing, funk, latin, fusion styles are again woven together throughout the album, as well as guest appearances from the fabulous Mike Miller (Chick Corea, Yellowjackets, Bette Midler) on guitar, and jazz master Mitchel Forman (Wayne Shorter, Mahavishnu, John Scofield) on piano.

This disc also includes the final jazz performances of pianist Wayne Christiansen, who has threaded every aspect of the Utah music scene and beyond for over 40 years. He has joined Double Helix on various performances throughout the band's ten year collaboration, including shows at the Deer Valley International Jazz Festival, and the Salt Lake Jazz Festival. All original organic Utah based jazz is alive and well with this latest release by "John Flanders & Double Helix".
