*The Nigerian Spam Scam Scam* originally opened in LA for a two night performance. After being featured in showcases in Las Vegas and Pasadena, CA the show went international, traveling to the Edinburgh Fringe Festival in 2004. Since then the show has enjoyed longer stints in LA while also traveling to theatres around the country. What has developed is a fine-tuned, quicker, faster version that is thrilling and hilarious. Dean Cameron plays the character he created, the lonely Florida millionaire, while Victor Isaac plays the tenacious Nigerian with the dialogue coming straight from the actual e-mail correspondence.
