For Immediate Release, Park City, February 18, 2011- Three of the hottest, black comics in the country have banded together as the Backpack, presenting black, white, and grey-area stand-up, in "S.E.L.L.O.U.T." Three unique comedians, one stage, at The Egyptian Theatre.

Vince Morris, Billy D. Washington, and BT each use comedy as art and laughter for a purpose to debunk racial and societal stereotypes.

The show is named S.E.L.L.O.U.T., because at some point in their careers, each comedian has been accused of not being true to his heritage, culture, or profession. Too Black for one venue. Not Black enough for another. A "sellout". However, in this show they choose to present their comedy their way, celebrating their motto: "Be Yourself. Because Everybody Else Is Already Taken."

Audiences love their final segment, "Ask a Blackman Anything". Encouraged to ask anything they have always wanted to know but were afraid to ask, the audience gets to take a swing at their own perceived walls of division.

The Mary G. Steiner Egyptian Theatre, a 501©(3) charitable organization, built in 1926, designed to seat 400 and to accommodate both movies and vaudeville. It was the first "sound movie" theater in Park City and is an icon worldwide in connection to Robert Redford's Sundance Film Festival held every year in January in Park City, Utah. We are one of only two "Egyptian" Theatres' in Utah. In November of 2010 The Egyptian Theatre opened it's Egyptian Studio's featuring a black box theatre. Currently the theatre hosts a variety of plays, musical acts, special events, community fundraisers and more.
