a prophetic rock musical

For Immediate Release, Park City, February 22, 2011- Jonathan Larson, creator of "Rent", dies at age 35 on the eve of his greatest achievement.

Earning two Tony Awards to the Pulitzer Prize for Drama, the legacy he left behind would change the sound and face of Broadway and the theatre forever and be heard around the world.

"tick, tick...Boom!", presented by Dark Horse Company Theatre, is his story, in his own words. With driving rock music alongside beautiful and hauntingly prophetic melodies, Jonathan Larson tells a story of passion and perseverance as a promising young composer in New York City, 1990. It is story for anyone who has ever had to choose between their dreams and the harsh realities of real life. His work and sacrifice would become the voice of a new generation as "Rent".

Larson began to perform the piece as a solo work in 1990. After his death in 1996, it was revised and revamped by playwright David Auburn as a three-actor piece and was premiered off-Broadway in 2001. Since then, the show has had a London production, an American national tour and numerous national productions.

As his 30th birthday quickly approaches, Jon is worried he has made the wrong career choice as a "promising young composer." The clock is ticking in more ways than he could ever imagine. He faces life-changing decisions about his career, his relationships, and his art.

"tick, tick... BOOM!" will kick-off the Musicals on Main Series that brings together Dark Horse Company Theatre, Plan-B Theatre Company and The Egyptian Theatre to bring high quality productions to new audiences while showcasing the works of established companies in a historic Utah venue. The series is being sold as a package and for \$45 patrons will get a ticket to each of the three shows: "tick, tick... Boom!", Plan-B's "Gutenberg coming in June, and Dark Horse Company Theatre's "Gypsy" which will debut in July. Individual tickets for the shows start at \$18.
