Randolph's act is innovative and loose, all at once planned and unplanned using audience interaction to build on his own musings about religion, drugs travels, and how we interact with each other. Randolph performs at top venues all over the west such as "The Ice House" and "The Laff Stop" he also has numerous television appearances and has appeared with many personalities from B.B. King to The B-52s.
