The Egyptian Theatre is excited to celebrate it's 30 year anniversary in 2011 after the theatre was restored to it's Egyptian architectural roots in 1981. Before the remodel, the 1960s through about 1978 The Egyptian Theatre was renamed The Silver Wheel Theatre when Park City went through a rebirth to become a ski town. The usual fare at the theatre at the time were old fashioned melodramas. *Someone Save My Baby, Ruth!* is a fun return to the melodrama fare with a sweet twist that gives a nod to the rich history of the theatre. The cast features locals from Park City and Salt Lake that help add to the richness of the history of the theatre.

Following the performances every night will be ImprovAbilities, Park City's newest comedic improv troupe. The cast includes experienced improvisers who have performed at venues across the nation and newcomers to the improv scene. They will have you rolling on the floor laughing and always guessing at what will happen next.

If you're looking for something a little sweet, funny and mysterious this winter The Egyptian Theatre is the place to be. Don't miss *Someone Save my Baby, Ruth!*
