The Egyptian Theatre celebrates April Fools weekend with 2 hilarious stand-up comedians in "Stand-Up Like an Egyptian" Friday-Saturday, April 1-2, 2011. Both shows at 8:30 pm.

The Egyptian Theatre continues to cultivate a strong following for its various and frequent comedy shows. Stand-Up Like an Egyptian is a recurring show throughout the year, MC'd by local humorist Kathleen McCann, with a revolving cast of headlining and featured comedians.

The April Fools weekend shows will be headlined by nationally-acclaimed comedienne Roz Browne, and will feature Salt Lake's own, Cody Eden.

ROZ BROWNE has kept audiences laughing since 1992 when she first began to pursue her dream. "A high school teacher told me I can make a lot of money as a CPA. So that's what I did. Then I found out later that the teacher was just kidding," states Browne who performs regularly at the world famous Comedy Store and at The Laugh Factory in Hollywood. Taught by Gary Austin, founder of The Groundlings, Browne has excellent improve-abilities and has been steadily making her presence known in Hollywood.

She has also appeared on America's Funniest People, Comedy Time and Que Locos Comedy Jam. Browne has toured as a Stand Up Comedian nationally and as a USO performer in Asia and Hawaii. She was a finalist in California's Funniest Female Contest in 2005 and voted Favorite Comedian by Boston Metro Choice's Newspaper during the 2006 Boston Comedy Festival.

Cody Eden is quirky and fun and he'll have you chuckling even when you don't think you should be laughing. You can see him regularly at Mo's in SLC. Shows start each night at 8:30pm, doors open at 8:00pm. Tickets (fee's included): Adults \$18 in advance, \$20 at the door. This show is Adults Only.

Additionally, for the comedy-lover, the Egyptian Theatre hosts the weekly Improv comedy show, IMPROVabilities, every Saturday night in the Egyptian Studios, located on the lowest floor of the Main Street Mall (333 Main St). This show is all ages appropriate and patrons can BYOB (if of drinking age). "IMPROVabilities is the perfect Saturday night segue between dinner and the bars," says Jack Diamond, the show's Producer. He says they have developed quite a consistent clientele who come every week, but they still have some seats to spare. Show: every Saturday night at 9pm. Tickets are \$10, cash at the door.

The Mary G. Steiner Egyptian Theatre, a 501©(3) charitable organization, built in 1926, designed to seat 400 and to accommodate both movies and vaudeville. It was the first "sound movie" theater in Park City and is an icon worldwide in connection to Robert Redford's Sundance Film Festival held every year in January in Park City, Utah. We are one of only two "Egyptian" Theatres' in Utah. In November of 2010 The Egyptian Theatre opened its Egyptian Studio's featuring a black box theatre. Currently the theatre hosts a variety of plays, musical acts, special events, community fundraisers and more.
