**For Immediate Release: Park City, UT, May 26, 2011-**

11th House Productions brings the island music and movements of Jamaican Dancehall Reggae to the Egyptian Theatre in Park City this June 24th. "Decorate Di Dance Floor" will celebrate Jamaican culture through dancehall choreography, club-style reggae, and flashy, colorful costumes. It promises to be a Jamaican Summerfest in the mountains!

Decorate di Dance Floor was the brainchild of SunnyMarz, a Jamaican-born, local Park City resident and member of a very talented family of performers. She wanted to bring all the family's varied talents to one stage, and so, created a showcase where three generations and six family members can perform. To round it off, she also opened auditions to other singers and dancers who could embody the island vibe. Nine dancers and singers will take the stage, backed fully by The Patwa Reggae Band.

SunnyMarz and her sister MekaDayz, who own 11th House Productions, are the main choreographers and dancers in the show. They also both sing and perform regularly with their father's band, The Patwa Reggae Band. MekaDayz explained the distinctions of Dancehall Reggae, saying, "Dancehall is different from the Rocksteady Reggae people know from Peter Tosh and Bob Marley. Dancehall was the mother of hip hop, so it has a faster, stronger beat, more of a party beat. When people go out to Dancehall reggae clubs they dress very flashy and extravagantly. The dance moves are much stronger, sexier, and are more tribal, even African."

MekaDayz currently teaches Dancehall Reggae for fitness in a weekly class. She says the dance moves are a fun, sexy, energetic way to work out, similar to a Zumba class, and can also help the shy dancer feel more confident. Two of her students are appearing in the "Decorate di Dance Floor" show.

At the Egyptian Theatre, the dancers will be backed by The Patwa Reggae Band, a well-known and locally-based Reggae band. The Patwa Reggae Band has appeared with national acts such as Tosh Meets Marley and Giant Panda Guerilla Dub Squad. Band Members are: Colin Higgins, Zach Thomas, Errol Grant (father), Jarryd Wark, and Swainson Holness (cousin).

Decorate Di Dance Floor promises to be a vibrant night of color, culture, rhythm, sure to get the audience's blood pumping and energy up!
